

Make a Treasure Chest

What You Need

Printout of page two, Scissors, Glue,
Crayons/Pencils/Felt Tips

What to Do

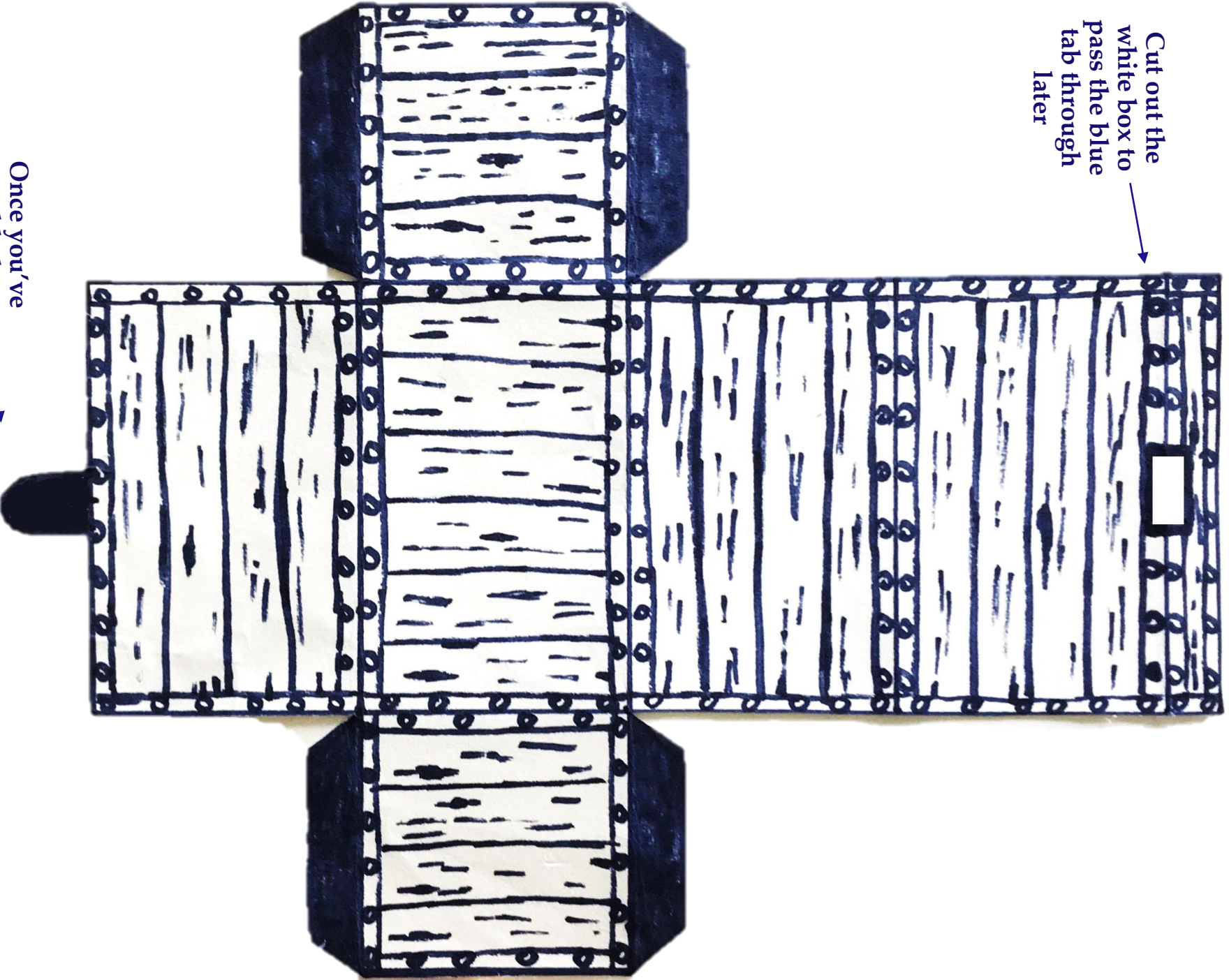
1. Colour in your treasure chest. Most treasure chests were made of brown wood with brass edges but you can use any colours you like!
2. Ask a grown up to help you cut out your treasure chest template. Cut out the white box to create a gap to pass the blue tab through later
3. Fold the sides up and the blue tabs in
4. Put glue on the blue tabs and tuck them in to stick your treasure chest together
5. Fold the lid down and pass the blue tab through the gap to secure it shut. You can draw a padlock on the back of the blue tab to make your treasure extra secure! What will you keep in your treasure chest?
